Picture Day

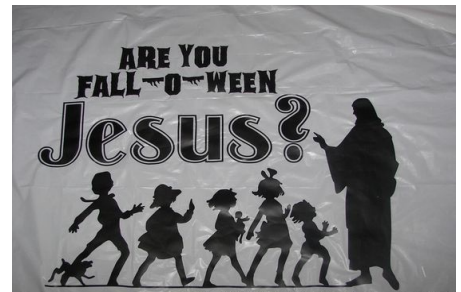
Fall Picture Day is **October 4,2016**. Fall pictures will be taken in our chapel uniforms.
